*To all members,*

*As we enter 2021 and competitions begin to go ahead in some areas, this is a reminder of certain Constitutional Rules and Regulations.*

**PLEASE READ THE FOLLWING IF YOU ARE A COMPETIOR IN THE SHOW RING.**

1. *The registered owner of the Pinto must be a current financial VPS member.*
2. *Fillies & Geldings, 2yrs of age & older must be adult registered with the VPS*
3. *Stallions 4yrs & over must be adult registered with the VPS*

## **Whip Length Limitations as of August 2017**

All members must not use or carry any whips, canes, crops or hacking canes exceeding 75 centimetres in its entirety (including the tassel) when leading, riding or holding a horse or pony.

This rule applies to all Pinto classes and events ( excluding dressage and harness )

EG. All VPS conducted events and all Pinto classes at Agricultural, Breed Show, Royal Events, Open Horse Shows and Horse of The Year Events.

It has been brought to my attention that some members have lapsed with the Whip Length Limitation.

### **THIS RULE WILL BE ENFORCED IN THE PINTO RING AT BARASTOC**

Furthermore to clarify – There will not be any Annual High Point Awards this season.

A Highpoint competition can not be conducted when there are minimal shows proceeding within the state and our own Society conducted events postponed until next season.
