The '3' will be followed by two letters for your shire, then a letter for your parish, then another letter which is used to check the validity of each PIC, and then three numbers for your property, eg. 3ABCD123. If an email address is supplied for the Livestock Owner (Section 1) you will be sent an email notifying you of your new PIC. If no email address is supplied you will be posted a letter notifying you of your new PIC.
